
Health and Wellbeing

- Rights Respecting School






Literacy



Reading, writing and listening and talking are taught through:

- RWInc Phonics
- Comprehensions
- Foundations for Writing
- Spelling
- Handwriting
- Focused listening and talking opportunities
- Play based learning
- Reading books will be sent out weekly. Can book bags with reading books please be returned every day to support with reading groups. The books should be returned on a Friday and you will receive a new book on Mondays.



Numeracy and Mathematics



- We follow a skills progression based on the Curriculum for Excellence E&Os.
- Children develop their knowledge and practice their applications of a range of different numeracy and mathematics concepts including: number word sequences and numeral, number structures and place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division and fractions.

This year in P2, our learning contexts will be developed through the children's interests observed during play based learning experiences.


In term 1, we have introduced a learning focus surrounding dinosaurs. Our planned stimulus for the other terms are:
