## Our Rights journey so far...

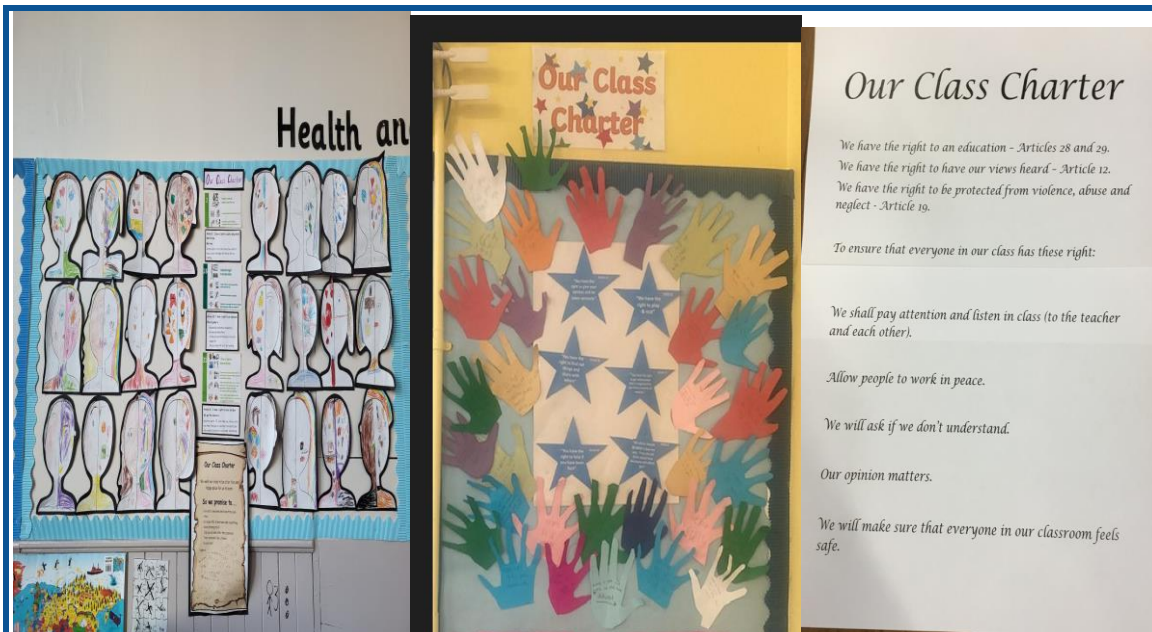
At Newtongrange Primary School we successfully achieved our Bronze Award in 2019 and are currently we are working towards our Silver Award
