**Primary 7 – Term 4**

<p><b>Health and Well Being</b> We will continue with our Building Resilience Programme this term is, "Active and Responsible." This will give our learners an opportunity to explore how to become more active and be more responsible, particularly in their role as Senior 7s and as buddies to Primary 1. We continue to progress through the RSHP as a year group. P7 will be working through athletics in P.E. and taking part in Wider Curriculum activities.</p>	<p><b>Literacy</b> We are working on creative writing in Term 4 and there will also be an opportunity for free writing where the learners can take responsibility for their own learning and actively choose the genre of their writing. We will be working towards every learner exploring a wider variety of texts for reading as well as a whole class Novel Study.</p>	<p><b>Numeracy and Mathematics</b> Term 4 will focus on revision of the four processes each week to progress skills and strategies before High School. We will be delving deeper into fractions, decimals and percentages and continuing to progress our skills in algebra. We will be encouraging our learners to look at maths and its impact on the world.</p>
<p><b>Ethos and Wider Life of the School</b> Term 4 brings new wider curriculum options for our learners. P7T will continue their role as Digital Leads across the school while P7H will progress their role as Play Pioneers and will be instrumental in shaping Newtongrange Primary School's first ever National Play Day at the end of May. We are actively encouraging our learners to share any achievements they receive outside school. Please encourage your child to share any exciting achievements.</p>		<p><b>Learning across the Curriculum</b> Our context for learning will focus on our Primary 7 Show "I'm an 11 Year Old Get Me Out of Here". The show has been cast and rehearsals are underway. All songs are available in Google Classroom and on Spotify and we are encouraging our learners to engage with these as much as possible. Our learners continue to explore and enhance their digital skills by using their digital bookmarks. This is important in the run up to High School where most school work is carried out on their individual device.</p>
